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## COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

### Site Access

- Bump in will be between 8:00 am and 3:30 pm, Friday 31<sup>st</sup> May.
- Bump out will begin at the conclusion of the event from 7.30pm Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2024.
- Teams who show up late will not be admitted on to the site.
- There will be no deliveries during event hours, only before the gates open, each day.

### Camping

- The event is being held on Private Property. Tents and Swags ok, as it is officially an all- night cooking event.
- There are many accommodation facilities close by, if you would like assistance with a list, don't hesitate to ask.

### Cars

- All cars and vehicles are to be removed from Site!!
- Any vehicles wanting access during event times will not be allowed on Site.
- All cars need to be off site from: 4pm Friday

### Hot Coals

- Metal bins will be supplied. Each Team is responsible for disposing of hot coals.

### Gardens and Parklands

- Please take care of natural Flora in the area; do not use trees or branches in any way with your competition area.
- No signs to be attached to the trees in the parklands.

### Conduct

- All Teams and their members must behave in a professional and courteous manner at all times.
- Teams must take direction from the Event Management and security staff at all times.

### Team Cancellation

- Cancellations must be notified in writing 14 days prior to the event or the full fee will be forfeited.

### Site Restrictions

- No pets or livestock will be permitted on the event site.
- Use of amplified music by Teams is prohibited.
- Teams may not use inappropriate products; counterfeit, weapons, dangerous or illegal items are not allowed on the site.
- Teams must adhere to the Townsville BBQ Battle entry conditions and not bring any prohibited items into the site: No alcohol or illicit drugs, animals (except in accordance with legislation), fire/fireworks, video cameras or professional cameras.

## Marquees

- Each Team will be provided with a site measuring 6m x 6m.
- Teams are responsible for bringing their own Marques/Gazebos, BBQ's and any other equipment needed for the competition.
- Marques/Gazebos and Umbrellas must be weighed down with suitable weights; such as sand bags or specially designed weights. Pegging is NOT permitted due to underground services.
- If pegging is required you must contact the event organiser to consult with the Private property owner.

## Garbage and Recycling

- The event will supply bins for general waste, recyclable products including cardboard and grey water (nothing is to be disposed of down drains or in garden beds).
- It is your responsibility to sort and dispose of your rubbish. Please contact the BBQ Coordinator if you have any queries.
- All oils must be removed from the site at the end of the event
- Sites must be left as they were found. It is your responsibility to remove ALL waste and ensure site is left clean and tidy.
- Only biodegradable ecologically sound detergents and cleaning fluids will be permitted for use.

## Fire Extinguisher

- Food, preparation and refreshment areas must have appropriate separate hand-held fire extinguishers and fire blankets as necessary and available at all times during occupation.

## Security

- All effort is made to secure the site but no responsibility will be taken for loss or damage to any person or goods whether or not that loss, damage or injury arises from the negligence of staff or contractors employed by the Townsville BBQ Battle.

## Alcohol Policy

- Teams understand that the site has a licensed area, and you will need to comply with the Liquor Act of 2007.
- Each Team understand that their Team site is in a Licensed area.
- Townsville BBQ Battle will not tolerate any Team consuming BYO Alcohol. Any Team found drinking their own alcohol will be asked to leave the site and forfeit your entry to the BBQ competition.
- If any Teams are found to be intoxicated, violent, suspected of using or is using illicit drugs you will be asked to leave the premises, and you will forfeit your entry into the Townsville BBQ Battle grounds.
- If any Teams members are found to supplying or buying alcohol for a minor you will be evicted from the Townsville BBQ Battle grounds and the matter recorded into the Incident Register and may face criminal charges.

## Video and Photography

- Each Team agrees to being photographed or recorded for use in our promotional (in which you have no rights including to a copy thereof), and that you have no right to pre-approval of, and no entitlement to payment for any such use.



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## Termination

- If this agreement is breached Townsville BBQ Battle reserves the right to terminate this agreement.
- Townsville BBQ Battle Management reserves the right to expel any BBQ Competition Team or Team Member at any time in consultation with the Australasian Barbecue Alliance.

## Refunds

- Refunds will not be issued. Refunds will NOT be issued in the event of bad weather, late arrival, last minutes cancellations or change of mind. In the event of cancellation due to inclement weather, transfer of dates and charges will not turn over to a future event.

## Electricity

- Each Team will be provided with 1 x 10-amp power connection.
- Additional power connections are available: \$20 for 10a, \$25 for 15a, and \$75 for 32a.
- All electrical appliances must be in safe working order and have current test tags fitted.
- Equipment without a valid tag will not be connected.
- Teams must provide their own lights, leads and power boards fitted with circuit breakers. Any damage caused by electrical over-consumption/overload or misuse will attract penalties or forfeiture of bond.

## BBQ Competition Member Access

- There is no restriction to the number of members in a team.
- Access is for the entire duration of the Townsville BBQ Battle (Friday and Saturday), and is strictly for Team Members only.

## Prize Money

- Prize Money awarded will be paid by directly to the teams on the Saturday night of the event.

## Copyright

- Audio or visual recordings of the Event are prohibited.
- Still cameras are permitted but images may only be used for private purposes and not public display.
- By Competing in the Event, Teams consent to being included in any film and/or sound recordings of the Event that may take place and agree for these recordings to be used by the Event Organiser.
